

# Amateur (HAM) Radio Operator

Along with all other requirements, you must provide:

- A completed [Application for Amateur Radio Operator Registration Plates](#).

If you have a passenger vehicle, you can apply for a different plate background, but be sure to add the fees listed on the [application](#) for the plate you want to your total fee from the charts below.

# Antique

Antique registration is permanent and only one plate is issued. Any vehicle that can be registered may get Antique registration if it meets the antique requirements listed below.

To qualify:

- Your vehicle must be maintained as a collector's item; and
- Your vehicle must be older than half the number of years between the current year and 1900.



Along with all other requirements, you must provide:

- A completed [Antique Vehicle Declaration](#).

# National Guard

Along with all other requirements, you must provide:

- Proof that you are an active member of the Oregon National Guard by submitting an Oregon Military Certificate of Eligibility, AGO Form 4309 with all other requirements.

You can contact your unit commander to get Form 4309.

# Special Interest

Special Interest registration is permanent and only one plate is issued.

To qualify, your vehicle must be:

- Maintained as a collector's item; **and**
- At least 25 years old; or
- Sanctioned as Special Interest by an established organization; or
- A street rod; or
- A high-mobility multipurpose wheeled vehicle (HMMWV); or
- A racing activity vehicle.
  - **ATTENTION: If your vehicle was originally manufactured as a passenger vehicle, it DOES NOT qualify as a racing activity vehicle, even if modifications have been made.**



Along with all other requirements, you must provide:

- A completed [Special Interest Vehicle Declaration](#).
