- Moped
- Passenger (See the <u>Passenger Plate page</u> for options and fees)

To qualify you must:

- Have a valid amateur radio license;
- Submit an Application for Amateur Radio Operator Plates with your title or registration application.

# Antique

Antique registration is permanent and only one plate is issued. Any vehicle that can be registered may get Antique registration if it meets the antique requirements listed below.

To qualify:

- Your vehicle must be maintained as a collector's item;
- Your vehicle must be older than half the number of years between the current year and 1900; and
- You must submit an <u>Antique Vehicle Declaration</u> with your <u>title</u> or <u>registration application</u>.

## **Disabled Veteran**

### These plates cannot be used to park in Disabled Person Parking spaces.

Disabled Veteran registration is permanent. A qualifying veteran can only have <u>one plate or set of plates</u>. Any vehicle that can be registered may get disabled veteran plates **except**:

- Low-speed;
- Medium-speed; and
- Commercial vehicles.

To qualify you must:

- Provide proof that you have a service-connected disability; and
- Submit an <u>Application for Disabled Veteran Plates</u> with your <u>title</u> or <u>registration application</u>.

# **National Guard**

Vehicles eligible:

- Motor Home
- Passenger (See the <u>Passenger Plate page</u> for fees)

To qualify you must:



- Provide proof that you are an active member of the Oregon National Guard by submitting an Oregon Military Certificate of Eligibility, AGO Form 4309 with your <u>title</u> or <u>registration application</u>.
  - You can contact your unit commander to get Form 4309.

- Heavy trailer
- Light trailer
- Moped
- Motor home

- Passenger (See the <u>Passenger</u> <u>Plate page</u> for fees)

To qualify:

- Your vehicle must be maintained as a collector's item;
  - Your vehicle must be one of the following:
    - o At least 25 years old;
    - o Sanctioned as Special Interest;
    - o A street rod; or
    - o A racing activity vehicle; and
- You must submit a Special Interest Vehicle Declaration with your title or registration application.
