## ERRORS\*

### Top 10 Driver Errors:

1. Failed to avoid stopped or parked vehicle ahead
2. Ran off road
3. Failed to maintain lane
4. Failed to yield right-of-way
5. Following too closely
6. Driving too fast for conditions (not exceeding posted speed)
7. Inattention
8. Left turn in front of on-coming traffic
9. Failure to decrease speed for slower moving vehicle
10. Careless driving

### Top Pedestrian Errors:

1. Crossing between intersections
2. Failure to yield right-of-way
3. Disregarded traffic signal

### Top Bicyclist / Pedalcyclist Errors:

1. Failure to yield right-of-way
2. Disregarded traffic signal
3. Walking, running, riding, etc. on shoulder facing traffic
