

SPECIAL USE TRAILER SCHEDULE OF REGISTRATION FEES

This chart shows special use trailer registration fees, which are based on the trailer length. See page 2 of this form for how to determine the trailer length and for more information about this registration type. If the trailer is getting a new plate, a plate fee is also required. Trailers registered in **Multnomah** County are charged an additional \$112. Trailers registered in **Washington** or **Clackamas** Counties are charged an additional \$60.

ALL ABOUT SPECIAL USE TRAILERS

- 1. Special use trailers include trailers of any width that are used temporarily on a construction site for office purposes only and trailers eight feet or less in width used for business or commercial purposes.
- 2. Registration length is the total length of the trailer, measured from the trailer hitch to the rear-most extremity of the trailer. Round any fractions **down** to the nearest full foot.
- 3. Special use trailers are registered for a two-year period. They are issued one registration plate, which must be displayed on the rear of the trailer.
- 4. Special use trailers are **not** required to be continuously registered, but must be registered or operated with a valid trip permit, when used over the highways.
- 5. Any application for title must include the title fee and other applicable fees.
