

Policy: 23 CFR 511 Real-time System Management Information Program

- Construction information required
*..availability of information about full construction activities that **close** or **reopen roadways** or **lanes** will be **20 minutes or less** from the time of the closure for highways outside of Metropolitan Areas and **10 minutes or less** from the time of the closure or reopening for roadways within Metropolitan areas.*
- Recently passed FHWA audit
