02040.10 – Chemical Admixture, Type S

ODOT has a list of Type S Chemical Admixtures on the Qualified Products List (QPL). Initially, each manufacturer submits their request with documentation, test reports, etc. for each product they wish to have listed on the QPL. Upon acceptance and placement onto the QPL, the product then becomes available for use on upcoming projects, but certification and additional testing of the product may be required for each project the category is proposed for use on. The admixture will need to be included with the project mix design.

Provide to ODOT for QPL Evaluation:

1. Furnish a report on the specific performance characteristic that this product offers.
2. Furnish data from either an independent laboratory or a report from third party-witnessed testing, to substantiate the specific performance characteristics stated. This data shall be current, clear, and to the point.
3. Furnish an independent test report showing compliance with ASTM C494.
4. Return a copy of this page with the appropriate box checked above. Separate submittals are required for each box you check, or if you have several models for the same category.
5. Furnish a current list of 5 recent projects utilizing the type of bearing being submitted. Include names and contact information for the owner of the project.

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6. Furnish 4 copies of Shop Drawings, Brochures, Engineering Calculations, Product Literature, and anything else you believe we need to complete our review.
7. Furnish Certification that the product provides specific performance characteristics without any adverse effects on fresh, hardened and durability properties of concrete.
8. Submit a completed [the Preliminary Information for Product Evaluation Form.](#)
