SIGN COVERS, TEMPORARY;

00225.11 – Sign Covers, Temporary

General - ODOT maintains a list of products suitable for placement over the face of a temporary sign substrate that will completely cover the face of the sign. These products are designed to make the sign un-readable, and not damage the sign in any way. We require Construction projects to use sign covers from the Qualified Products List (QPL). One-piece plywood units do not need to be on the QPL, but acceptance of those will be on a job by job basis.

Specifications: Sign covers for temporary signs shall be:

- One-piece plywood or another material if approved (polyethylene film or canvas will not be allowed)
- Large enough to completely cover the sign
- Easy to attach to and remove from the sign without damaging the sign face
- Black, non-reflective, and opaque
- Stay in place in stormy conditions.

To apply for inclusion on the QPL, submit the following:

- Preliminary information for Product Evaluation Form.
- Evidence that you meet the specifications listed above.
- Detailed pictures or brochures showing the device in use.
- Detailed installation instructions.
- List of any limitations and precautions.
- A sample of the sign cover material.
