

Maptech Terrain Navigator

- This software is a tool to be used with the Garmin Handheld GPS receiver
- It uses a series of CDs., which cover regions of the United States.
- The CDs Contain U.S.G.S. Quadrangle Maps.
- Most useful to ODOT is the Pacific Northwest (Wa., Or.), which contains:
 - Seven CDs. covering Oregon.
 - Six CDs. covering Washington.
 - Four CDs. Of Washington and Oregon National Parks.
 - An installation CD.
 - An Enhanced Digital Elevation CD for the West Coast.
- Terrain Navigator can be used to:
 - Mark waypoints, tracks and routes
 - Upload waypoints, tracks and routes to the Garmin GPS handheld.
 - Download waypoints, tracks and routes to the map.
 - Mark waypoints by measuring a bearing and distance.
 - Measure a line and view line of sight and profile.
 - View a portion of the map in 3-D.
- Maps can be viewed as a single quad or in seamless view.
- The cost of each copy of Terrain Navigator is 150.00 dollars.
