

Activity 092 Underground Storage Tank Removal

Description

Activity 092 involves removing underground storage tanks and cleaning up contamination from leakage. It includes disposing of tanks and contents, sampling and testing of soils, treating/disposing of contaminated soil, treating contaminated groundwater, restoring the site, and costs of consultant fees, laboratory analyses, and fines from regulatory or other agencies.

General Information

Seek assistance from the District Manager, Region Hazmat Coordinator, and Region Environmental Coordinator as needed.

Before beginning the work, obtain a Special EA from the Maintenance Management System (MMS) Unit in the ODOT Transportation Program Office.

Follow accepted practices to obtain consultants, laboratory analyses, etc. Refer to the Purchase and Acquisition of Goods and Services section of this Guide.

Measurement of Accomplishment, Expenditure Account, Charge Activity

Measurement is number of worker hours involved. Expenditure account type is Special EA.
