

Activity 093 Hazardous Material Removal and Disposal (ODOT Generated)

Description

Activity 093 involves identifying, testing, removing, and disposing of hazardous materials generated by ODOT. It includes emergency and extraordinary cleanup of the waste and any damage or contamination resulting from leaks, monitoring of health or the environment, consultant fees, laboratory analyses, disposal fees, and fines from regulatory or other agencies.

General Information

Refer to discussion in the General Instructions section preceding Activity 014 in this section of the *Maintenance Guide* for additional information including environmental and traffic control recommendations and other important considerations.

Refer to Activity 092 for work related to underground storage tanks.

Refer to Activity 307 for work related to hazardous material that is on ODOT property but is the responsibility of others.

Seek assistance from the District Manager, Region Hazmat Coordinator, and Region Environmental Coordinator as needed.

As appropriate, refer to instructions in the *ODOT First Responder Guide to Highway Incident Response* and in the *Emergency Response Guidebook*

Before beginning the work, obtain a Special EA from the Maintenance Management System (MMS) Unit in the ODOT Transportation Program Office.

Follow accepted practices to obtain consultants, laboratory analyses, etc. Refer to the Purchase and Acquisition of Goods and Services section of this Guide.

Measurement of Accomplishment, Expenditure Account, Charge Activity

Measurement is number of worker hours involved. Expenditure account type is Special EA.
