


WORK WILL BEGIN IN SUMMER 2012 to grind and pave U.S. 26 (Sunset Highway) in both directions between the Sylvan Interchange and I-405 in the City of Portland. This 2-mile stretch of highway was last repaved in 1994 and is severely rutted. Project completion is slated for summer 2013. The following elements will be included in the project:

- Grind and pave U.S. 26 in both directions between the Sylvan interchange and I-405. This includes the highway lanes, shoulders and ramps (milepost 71.53 to milepost 73.72)
- Repair pavement at the Vista Ridge Tunnel entrances
- Install one new sign structure and replace one sign structure
- Upgrade highway signs in the project area
- Replace approximately 60 illumination poles and lights between the Zoo and Vista Ridge Tunnel
