

# OR 99W: Gaarde/McDonald Intersection Improvement Project

Fact Sheet – February 2015

## Construction is here!


Construction on the OR 99W: Gaarde/McDonald intersection has begun and will continue through 2015. This \$10.9 million project to improve traffic flow and safety is a collaboration between ODOT, City of Tigard and Washington County.

### Traffic impacts

- OR 99W: Lane closures will occur at night. Daytime work will take place off the roadway with no impact to traffic.
- Gaarde St., McDonald St. and Canterbury Ln.: Lane closures will occur weekdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and at night.
- Construction will take place days and nights, with most work Sunday through Thursday nights.
- Weekend work may also occur.
- There will be short-term intermittent sidewalk closures. Signed ADA-accessible pedestrian detours will be provided during sidewalk closures.
- Unavoidable short-term driveway closures will be communicated individually to businesses and residents during construction.
- Road users should expect increased congestion and delays in the project area. Please travel safely.



### Project snapshot



### Key improvements on OR 99W

- Southbound – Additional through lane and dedicated right turn lane for Bull Mountain Road
- Northbound – Additional left turn lane for Gaarde St. and a right turn only lane for McDonald St.
- Median planter, retaining walls, new traffic signals, water treatment and storm water facility upgrades

### Key improvements on Gaarde/McDonald

- A second through lane for both the east and west travel directions
- Crosswalk on the north side of the intersection will be reopened
- Retaining walls, sidewalks, bike lanes, light poles and storm water facility upgrades
