



# U.S. 26 (Mt. Hood Highway)

## *E. Burnside to S.E. Cherryville Drive*


### PROJECT LOCATION

U.S. 26 (Mt. Hood Highway) between E. Burnside Street in Gresham (milepost 14.2) and S.E. Cherryville Drive in Cherryville (milepost 30.4).

### PROJECT SUMMARY

This is a pavement preservation project that includes:

- Re-paving and striping U.S. 26 from:
  - E. Burnside (milepost 14.2) to the west city limits of Sandy (milepost 22.5)
  - S.E. Luzon Lane (milepost 26.3) to S.E. Cherryville Drive (milepost 30.4), with the exception of one-half mile near Shorty's Corner
- Re-paving and striping the Highway 212 (Clackamas-Boring Highway) ramps to and from U.S. 26.
- Installing rumble strips (which alert drivers when they drift from their lane) on U.S. 26 between S.E. Luzon Lane (milepost 26.3) and S.E. Cherryville Drive (milepost 30.4).



### PURPOSE AND NEED

Areas of pavement along this section of U.S. 26 are fatigued and in need of rehabilitation; rutting and potholes also exist in certain areas.

### PROJECT TIMELINE

ODOT anticipates opening bids in June 2010 to select a contractor for the project. Construction may take two seasons to complete. The first season is estimated to begin in late July 2010 and be completed by October 2010. Should the project require a second construction season, work will take place in the spring and summer of 2011.

### PROJECT IMPACTS

During construction, ODOT expects that there will be intermittent single lane closures with flaggers controlling traffic, and that both daytime and nighttime work will take place. Updates will be communicated as we near the start of construction.
