I-84 Troutdale project open house on May 2

Join ODOT staff for a look at the interchange improvement project at I-84 exit 17

The Oregon Department of Transportation invites the public to an open house to learn more about the Interstate 84 at Troutdale interchange project on Monday, May 2. The contractor on the \$2.7 million Troutdale interchange construction project is Vancouver, Wash.-based Nutter Corp.

Construction is expected to begin in May on this project to improve safety and capacity in the area of the I-84/257th Avenue interchange (at exit 17) in Troutdale. The project is scheduled to be completed by December 2011. The project is funded by Oregon House Bill 2001, the Jobs and Transportation Act (JTA).

ODOT will host a project **Open House on Monday, May 2, 2011.**

Project Background

The I-84 Troutdale JTA project includes the following improvements:

- Widening the I-84 eastbound exit ramp, and improving the intersection at Marine Drive in Troutdale
- Adding a third lane to South Frontage Road
- Widening the intersection at the I-84 westbound exit ramp at Graham Road and adding a third lane to North Frontage Road
