LANE STRIPING ON HIGHWAY 47

A contractor working for the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) is striping Highway 47 between Vernonia and the U.S. 26 interchange. This is one of the final steps of the Highway 47 paving project. Weather permitting, the contractor plans to work Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day for approximately 4 weeks. The contractor will start in Vernonia and continue south to U.S. 26 during the month-long project.

In order to reduce traffic delays, striping will occur in ½ mile – 1 mile sections at a time. In the active construction zones, traffic will be reduced to one lane with flaggers controlling both directions of travel. A pilot car will be used to safely move motorists through the work zone. Expect delays of up to 10 minutes during work hours. Traffic will be restored to one lane in each direction during non-work hours.

There will be no work Saturday, May 28 or Monday, May 30 in observance of Memorial Day.
