### **Marshland District Road Closes for Two Months**

**U.S. 30 project west of Clatskanie replaces two Eilertsen Creek culverts with bridges**

ODOT contractors will close the west end of Marshland District Road for two months starting Monday at U.S. 30 five miles west of Clatskanie in Woodson at milepost 67.8.

Motorists will be able to continue to use the east end of Marshland District Road during the closure. Highway signs will direct motorists to the detour. Traffic on U.S. 30 will not be affected.

The closure is part of the \$2 million project replacing two Eilertsen Creek culverts with bridges, and allowing the creek to run more freely. The project, which will lessen the likelihood of a major debris flow reaching the road, comes four years after the 2007 flooding that closed the highway for several days.

Most work will be completed by December 2011 with final paving, striping and cleanup in 2012. Motorists should expect intermittent daytime flagging on U.S. 30 throughout the project.
