## TRAFFIC ADVISORY

### Weekend Overnight I-5 South Closures

*Motorists will use I-405 south during the overnight closures Friday through Sunday*

ODOT crews will close Interstate 5 southbound between the Fremont Bridge (Interstate 405) and the south end of the Marquam Bridge at night over the weekend of June 17-19. During the closure, motorists will still have access to Interstate 84 eastbound from I-5 southbound.

The I-5 southbound closures will begin at 10 p.m. Friday June 17, Saturday June 18 and Sunday June 19 with lanes re-opening at 6 a.m. Saturday and Sunday mornings and at 5 a.m. Monday.

To prevent motorists from entering the work zone, ODOT will close the following ramps:

- I-84 westbound to I-5 southbound
- North Greeley Avenue on-ramp to I-5 southbound

**Detour:** Motorists traveling southbound on I-5 will take Interstate 405 southbound over the Fremont Bridge to I-5 southbound.

During the I-5 southbound closures, ODOT crews will repair bridge joints, lighting and signs. The U.S. Geological Survey will also install accelerometers on the Marquam Bridge. Accelerometers measure bridge movements in the event of an earthquake.
