

## **Traffic Advisory**

### **WEEKEND CLOSURES ON I-5**

Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) maintenance crews are scheduled to work on several projects on Interstate 5 in the metro area this weekend. Dates and times of work are listed below.

- **Saturday, July 16:** Workers will close one of the two left-turn lanes from eastbound Lower Boones Ferry Road to northbound I-5 from 5 a.m. to 7 a.m. The lane closure will allow workers to install new sign brackets on the I-5 overpass of Lower Boones Ferry Road. Access to I-5 north will be maintained at all times
- **Saturday, July 16:** Workers will close the left lane of I-5 north at the I-5/I-405 split from 7 a.m. to 10 a.m. to repair median barrier. One lane of northbound I-5 will remain open at all times. This work will not impact the ramp to I-405 north
- **Sunday, July 17:** Workers will close the ramp from southbound I-5 to eastbound I-84 from 4 a.m. to 10 a.m. to complete electrical repair work. During the ramp closure period, motorists bound for I-84 east from I-5 south will take the Morrison Bridge/Highway 99E off-ramp, head west across the Morrison Bridge and then return eastbound on the Morrison Bridge to I-84 east. Detour signs will be in place to assist motorists

Motorists are asked to use caution while driving through the construction zones and to expect minor delays.
