Weekday delays coming through mid-June on the I-205 bike/ped path at Airport Way

Bicyclists and pedestrians using the I-205 Multi-Use Path at the Northeast Airport Way interchange will see delays weekdays through mid-June due to adjacent construction work.

Flaggers on the trail on the north side of Airport Way will stop bicyclists and pedestrians for up to 20 minutes at a time Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. The trail closures are necessary to protect the safety of bicyclists and pedestrians while large cranes and other heavy equipment work next to the trail.

The delays will affect people using the north-south portion of the path between Marine Drive and the bike/ped bridge over Airport Way, or using the portion of the path that crosses the I-205/Glenn Jackson Bridge from Vancouver, Wash. View a map of the closure area:

This work is part of ODOT's I-205 NE Airport Way interchange improvement project now under construction. This two-year project will build a new on-ramp from Airport Way westbound onto I-205 northbound and extend the existing bike/ped bridge over Airport Way across the new ramp.
