## TRAFFIC ADVISORY

### Routine inspection requires overnight closures on ramps connecting I-5 and I-84

*Motorists will take I-405 during the overnight ramp closures this week and weekend*

Contractors for the Oregon Department of Transportation will perform routine inspections on ramps connecting Interstate 5 and Interstate 84 starting tonight, May 28, ending Monday, June 3. The inspections are routine take place every two years.

#### **Traffic Impacts:**

The inspections require closing the following ramps overnight from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.:

- **I-84 westbound ramp to I-5 northbound**

**Detour:** Motorists can take I-5 southbound to I-405 northbound across the Fremont Bridge back to I-5 northbound.

- **I-5 southbound ramp to I-84 eastbound**

**Detour:** Motorists can take I-405 southbound to I-5 northbound to I-84 eastbound.

- **I-5 southbound ramp to the Morrison Bridge**

**Detour:** Motorists access downtown Portland by taking the Rose Quarter off-ramp (exit 302A) and using the Steel Bridge.

Only one ramp will close at a time. The inspections also require overnight intermittent lane closures between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. on I-5 and I-84.

Please be alert to crews and equipment on the roadway during this work.
