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## **Public meeting will present U.S. 30 road plan**

ODOT announced an Oct. 25 open house in Clatskanie to present and discuss a \$4 million project planned to improve U.S. 30 next year.

The road project is designed to improve safety and access on U.S. 30 between Swedetown Road and Highway 47 in the City of Clatskanie. The public meeting offers residents and interested individuals a chance to see the project plans and talk to ODOT staff.

**When:** Monday, Oct. 25 - stop by anytime from 5 - 7 p.m. There will be a short presentation by project staff at 5:45 p.m. Staff will be available for questions and one-on-one interactions.

**Where:** Clatskanie River Inn - 600 E Columbia River Hwy, Clatskanie

Construction is scheduled to begin in spring 2011 and be completed by next fall. Specific project elements include:

- Widening U.S. 30 at Van Street to accommodate a left-turn lane for eastbound/southbound traffic
- Striping a continuous left-turn lane on U.S. 30 between Van Street and the Clatskanie River Bridge
- Paving and striping a one-mile section of U.S. 30 in the project area
- Improving sidewalks throughout the project limits
- Reconstructing the existing bicycle/pedestrian path along U.S. 30 east of the Clatskanie River to meet ADA guidelines
- Upgrading signage, drainage and guardrail in the project area
- Modifying access to the highway to improve safety
