### **CANCELLED: I-405/Fremont Bridge lane, ramp closures next week**

**\*\*ODOT has cancelled the following work. It will be rescheduled for a future date:**

The Oregon Department of Transportation will close lanes on a four-lane section of northbound Interstate 405/Fremont Bridge (bottom deck) on the nights of **Sunday, May 13, through Wednesday, May 16.**

The closures will allow ODOT bridge crews to install vertical supports for new signs that are planned to replace a former sign bridge damaged by a vehicle with a high load last year. The closures are scheduled to take place from **10 p.m. to 5 a.m.** as follows:

- ◆ **The nights of Sunday, May 13, and Monday, May 14:** The three left lanes of northbound I-405/Fremont Bridge between the south end of the bridge and the Kerby Avenue/Legacy Emanuel Hospital exit will be closed for the sign work. In addition to the closure of the three lanes, the U.S. 30/Yeon Avenue on-ramp to northbound I-405/Fremont Bridge and the ramp connecting northbound I-405/Fremont Bridge to southbound Interstate 5 will be closed. Motorists wishing to take either of the ramps are advised to take I-405 southbound to either I-5 northbound or southbound, depending on their destination. All other ramps on the Fremont Bridge, including the Kerby Avenue/Legacy Emanuel Hospital exit, will be open during the sign work.
- ◆ **The nights of Tuesday, May 15, and Wednesday, May 16:** The right lane of northbound I-405/Fremont Bridge between the south end of the bridge and the Kerby Avenue/Legacy Emanuel Hospital exit will be closed for the sign work. All ramps, including the Kerby Avenue/Legacy Emanuel Hospital exit, will be open during the work.
