## HIGHWAY CLOSURE UPDATE

### U.S. 26 (Sunset Highway)

A landslide has closed lanes on U.S. 26 at milepost 24.5 (near Quartz Creek Bridge). One lane is open and flaggers are controlling both directions of traffic. Drivers should expect delays.

### Highway 6

Crews have made progress cleaning up several landslides that occurred yesterday. Access for local residents is available, however the highway remains closed to through traffic between milepost 39 and milepost 4.

### Highway 35

A section of Highway 35 between U.S. 26, milepost 57, and Baseline Road, milepost 80.08 will remain closed indefinitely. Heavy rain over the last 24 hours has sent tremendous amounts of rock, sand and debris onto the highway. Several sections of Highway 35 have been completely washed out.

Motorists should use Interstate 84, U.S. 26 or U.S. 197 as alternate routes.
