Highway 6 Closed; Debris Flow Warning Issued

The Oregon Department of Transportation closed Highway 6 between Timber Road Junction (MP 39) and Donaldson Creek (MP 4) on Monday, Nov. 6, because of hazardous road conditions, including slides, fallen trees and other debris. Drivers are advised to take U.S. 26 as an alternative.

At 9 a.m., the Oregon Department of Forestry issued a debris flow warning for Clatsop, Columbia, Tillamook and Yamhill counties. A warning also was issued for western Washington State. Motorists are advised to use extreme caution if they must travel in these areas. The debris flow warning is in effect until at least 6 a.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 7.
