Powell Blvd. exit from southbound I-205 closed nightly for TriMet light-rail project

Motorists will be directed to take the Division Street exit during 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. closures

The Powell Boulevard exit from southbound Interstate 205 will be closed nightly beginning Monday, June 11, and lasting approximately one month. The nighttime ramp closures will allow TriMet to work on its new 6.5-mile MAX line along I-205 between Gateway Transit Center and the Clackamas Town Center. Construction at Powell Boulevard includes excavation, removal of soils, installation of storm sewer pipe and bridge construction.

I-205 southbound to Powell Boulevard off-ramp closure details

- ◆ The ramp will be closed Monday through Friday nights from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- ◆ Motorists will be directed to take the Division Street off-ramp from southbound I-205
- ◆ Motorists can expect intermittent lane closures and delays on Powell throughout the summer
- ◆ The multi-use path and pedestrian bridge are now closed at Powell. The path will remain closed through fall 2008. The detour route is available by clicking on the link below
