### I-5 expansion joint and deck repair work

***Expect nighttime lane closures on I-5 south of Ross Island Bridge from Sept. 9-14***

Oregon Department of Transportation bridge maintenance crews plan to make expansion joint and deck repairs to three bridge structures on Interstate 5 from Sept. 9-14.

The work will require single and double lane closures on northbound and southbound I-5 during nighttime work hours of **8 p.m. to 5 a.m.** at the following locations:

- ◆ Sunday night, Sept 9, to Monday morning, Sept. 10: **Southbound I-5 at the Iowa Street** bridge structure, mile post 298.2 (about 0.5 mile south of the Corbett Ave. exit)
- ◆ Monday night, Sept. 10, to Tuesday morning, Sept. 11: **Northbound I-5 at the Iowa Street** bridge structure, mile post 298.2 (about 0.5 mile south of the Corbett Ave. exit)
- ◆ Tuesday night, Sept. 11, to Wednesday morning, Sept. 12: **Northbound I-5 at the Hood Street** bridge structure, mile post 299.8 (just south of the Ross Island Bridge)
- ◆ Wednesday night, Sept. 12, to Thursday morning, Sept. 13: **Southbound I-5 at the Hood Street** bridge structure, mile post 299.8 (just south of the Ross Island Bridge). The work will take place on the ramp connecting westbound Ross Island Bridge (U.S. 26) to southbound I-5. The ramp will remain open during the work
- ◆ Thursday night, Sept. 13, to Friday morning, Sept. 14: **Southbound and northbound I-5 at the 26<sup>th</sup> Avenue** bridge structure, mile post 296 (just north of the Taylors Ferry Road exit from northbound I-5)
