

## **Traffic Advisory**

### **INTERSTATE 5 CLOSURE SATURDAY NIGHT**

**All northbound lanes of Interstate 5 from the Marquam Bridge to the Fremont Bridge will be closed Saturday, Sept. 23 from 8 p.m. to 10 a.m.** The closure is required for work crews to paint and inspect a section of the Fremont Bridge. Motorists will have the following options during the closure:

- Motorists traveling north on I-5 will follow I-405 across the Fremont Bridge to return to I-5 north. Motorists headed to I-5 north from westbound I-84 will follow I-5 south to I-405 north to I-5 north.
- The Morrison Bridge on-ramp to I-5 north will be closed. Downtown motorists heading for I-5 north can take Naito Parkway to I-5 south, I-405 north to I-5 north.
- Motorists heading east on U.S. 26 (Sunset Highway) to I-84 can travel north on I-405, cross the Fremont Bridge and go south on I-5 to I-84.
- Motorists heading to I-5 north from the Rose Quarter will be directed to the Williams Ave. on-ramp to northbound I-5, which will take them to I-405 south over the Fremont Bridge to the Everett Street exit, where they will be directed back to I-405 north across the Fremont Bridge to I-5 north.

The work is weather dependent.
