### **I-84 weekend night work in Portland area**

***Sign, electrical and road repair work will take place Friday, Saturday nights***

Oregon Department of Transportation maintenance crews will be working on Interstate 84 in a couple of locations with lane and ramp closures this weekend. Electrical, sign replacement and road surface repair work will take place during nighttime hours on Friday, June 20, and Saturday, June 21, as follows:

- ◆ **From 10 p.m. on Friday night to 6 a.m. on Saturday morning, crews will be working on I-84 westbound at the Interstate 205 split (mile post 7.1).** During this electrical, sign installation and road surface work, westbound I-84 motorists will be directed to take the southbound I-205 ramp, which connects back to westbound I-84. This work also requires the closure of the 102<sup>nd</sup> Avenue on-ramp to westbound I-84 and the closure of the right two lanes of westbound I-84 from 148<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the I-84/I-205 split. All other ramps and lanes in the work area will remain open.
- ◆ **From 10 p.m. on Saturday night to 6 a.m. on Sunday morning, crews will replace an overhead sign on I-84 eastbound at 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue.** This work will require right and center lane closures on eastbound I-84 in the work area. The left lane and shoulder will remain open during this work; all ramps also will remain open.

**Motorists may experience short delays when traveling through the work areas. Please drive carefully and pay attention to construction traffic.**
