****REMINDER NOTICE: I-5 to close in both directions at Interstate Bridges Saturday night**

Traffic on I-5 to be rerouted for nighttime maintenance work on Saturday night, Sept. 8

Oregon Department of Transportation maintenance crews will close northbound and southbound Interstate 5 to **ALL** traffic at the Interstate Bridges on **Saturday night, Sept. 8, from 11 p.m. to Sunday morning, Sept. 9 at 8 a.m.**

Motorists should be aware that work crews will begin closing lanes on I-5 in both directions beginning at approximately 9 p.m. on Saturday night prior to the full closure at 11 p.m. when all northbound I-5 traffic will be diverted at Marine Drive, exit 307 (motorists bound for Hayden Island/Jantzen Beach will follow detour signs – see below for more).

ODOT thanks motorists and commercial truckers in advance for being patient and using alternate routes during this closure. Closing I-5 in both directions will enable ODOT to complete numerous tasks during one night. This closure only impacts I-5 at the Interstate Bridges. The following work is scheduled to take place during the closure:

- Concrete deck repair
- Striping
- Bridge inspection
- Bridge counter-weight repair
- Generator inspection with bridge test lifts
- Concrete barrier repair and straightening
- Pavement repair on the southbound I-5 approach
- Illumination repair and replacement
- Camera repair and replacement
- Drain and gutter cleaning
- Sign installation
- Cable safety net barrier repair

Detours

1. **Southbound** I-5 traffic will be routed east on SR 14 and south on Interstate 205.
2. **Northbound** I-5 traffic will be routed east on Interstate 84 and north on I-205; traffic north of I-84 will be routed east on U.S. Bypass 30/Lombard Street and north on I-205; traffic north of Lombard Street will be routed east on Marine Drive and north on I-205

Hayden Island/Jantzen Beach access

During the closure, motorists bound for Hayden Island and Jantzen Beach will exit northbound I-5 at Marine Drive, exit 307, and follow detour signs directing locals only back to northbound I-5 and to the Jantzen Beach/Hayden Island exit 308. The ramp to southbound I-5 from the island will be open during the closure.

Bike/Ped access during the closure

The bicycle/pedestrian path across the Interstate Bridges will be open during the I-5 closure. But bicyclists and pedestrians should expect delays due to the multiple bridge lifts scheduled during work hours.

ODOT-WSDOT cooperation

ODOT thanks the Washington Department of Transportation for its help in coordinating the Interstate Bridges closure. Variable message signs in Oregon and Washington will warn of the closure and direct motorists to the detour routes.
