Southbound Interstate Bridge inspection

Controlled weight tests to cause minimal delays on Wednesday, Oct. 31

A contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation plans to conduct stress tests on the southbound Interstate Bridge span tomorrow (Wednesday, Oct. 31). **Inspection crews will do approximately 8 controlled weight test runs across the southbound bridge from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Wednesday.**

During each inspection run, southbound I-5 traffic will undergo a rolling slowdown, resulting in minimal delays to motorists. The rolling slowdown will allow inspectors to determine stress levels provided by several ODOT trucks crossing several points on the southbound span.
