### Tree removal on Highway 99E

On Wednesday, Feb. 28, an Oregon Department of Transportation maintenance crew will remove a tree that is leaning over the right lane of southbound McLoughlin Boulevard (Highway 99E) and the adjacent bicycle/pedestrian trail near 15th Avenue in Oregon City. The tree is damaged and poses a threat to vehicle and pedestrian traffic.

ODOT workers will close one of the two southbound lanes of McLoughlin Boulevard and the bicycle/pedestrian trail on Wednesday between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. One southbound lane will remain open. Pedestrians and bicyclists will be flagged through the work area. This work will not affect northbound traffic.
