# Expect some delays on U.S. 30 during Sauvie Island Bridge festivities on Sunday

*Access to Sauvie Island will be intermittently blocked during parade*

The Oregon Department of Transportation advises motorists on U.S. 30 (Lower Columbia River Highway) to expect congestion and some delays through the Sauvie Island Bridge area on Sunday, June 22, from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.

On Sunday, Multnomah County will be holding dedication events, including a parade, to mark the completion of the new Sauvie Island Bridge. To facilitate the parade, which is scheduled to begin at approximately 12:45 p.m., ODOT will temporarily restrict access to Sauvie Island.

### Event details

A celebration for the newly constructed Sauvie Island Bridge will be held on Sunday, June 22, from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. The celebration will include a ribbon-cutting ceremony, a series of “first bridge crossings” by various groups, live music/family entertainment, food booths featuring Sauvie Island growers and informational booths.
