Cyclists heading to U.S. 30 this weekend

About 9,000 cyclists expected to travel on U.S. 30 from Rainier to Portland

Motorists and cyclists are urged to travel with caution along U.S. 30 (Lower Columbia River Highway) between Rainier and Portland this weekend. Nearly 9,000 cyclists plan to take part in the Cascade Bike Club's 2007 ride from Seattle to Portland. There are 2,200 cyclists expected to cross the Lewis & Clark Bridge at Rainier on Saturday, July 14, and travel to Portland via U.S. 30; 6,700 will cross the bridge on their way to Portland on Sunday, July 15. Riders will exit U.S. 30 at NW St. Helens Road in Portland and proceed along city streets to the Lloyd Center.
