Westbound U.S. 26 remains closed at the Vista Ridge Tunnel

****ODOT US 26 Update:** Westbound US 26 (Sunset Highway) remains completely closed west of the Vista Ridge Tunnel.

ODOT crews continue to clean up the area from slides earlier Thursday and are adding barricade to shield motorists from the slide area. Ramps to westbound U.S. 26 east of the tunnel remain closed until the highway is reopened. Eastbound U.S. 26 lanes are open.

There is no current estimate for reopening the highway to westbound motorists. Further updates will follow within the hour. Suggested detours for motorists heading west: southbound Interstate 5 to westbound Highway 217 to U.S. 26; or westbound U.S. 30 (Lower Columbia River Highway) to Cornelius Pass Road to U.S. 26.
