### Sunset Highway lane, ramp closures

#### ***Tunnel washing, automatic traffic counter installation to take place Friday night***

Tunnel washing and an automatic traffic counter installation project will require closures of lanes and ramps on eastbound Sunset Highway (U.S. 26) from east of the Canyon Road/PGE Park off-ramp, exit 73, through the Vista Ridge Tunnel. (The Canyon Road/PGE Park off-ramp will remain open during work hours.) The projects will take place from 10 p.m. on Friday, May 18, to 6 a.m. on Saturday, May 19 as follows:

- ◆ **Friday at 10 p.m. to Saturday at 2 a.m.** – The left and center lanes of eastbound Sunset Highway will be closed in the work area for tunnel washing and traffic counter installation. The ramps connecting eastbound Sunset Highway to both northbound Interstate 405 and Market Street/City Center also will be closed during these work hours. Motorists wanting to take the Fremont Bridge to northbound Interstate 5 can travel southbound on I-405 to the Marquam Bridge/northbound I-5. Motorists bound for the city can use the 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue exit from southbound I-405.
- ◆ **Saturday morning from 2 a.m. to 6 a.m.** – The center and right lanes of eastbound Sunset Highway will be closed in the work area. The ramp connecting eastbound Sunset Highway to southbound I-405 also will be closed during these work hours. Motorists headed for southbound I-5 or eastbound Interstate 84 can travel north on I-405 across the Fremont Bridge to southbound I-5. The Market Street/City Center ramp from eastbound Sunset Highway will remain open during the work.
