U.S. 26 paving scheduled to start Monday night

Road repair work will impact lanes at night from Cornell Boulevard to 185th Avenue

A contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation will repair sections of U.S. 26 (Sunset Highway) between 185th Avenue and Cornell Road during the next two weeks.

This roadway grinding and asphalt inlay project will require lane and intermittent ramp closures on both directions of Sunset Highway between 185th Avenue and Cornell Road.

Details of the road repair project

- ◆ Lane and ramp impacts will take place from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. nightly, Monday, Sept. 15, through Friday, Sept. 28. Crews will be working at numerous locations along both east and west directions of Sunset Highway in the paving operation.
- ◆ During some nighttime work hours, crews will intermittently close the ramp connecting northbound 185th Avenue to eastbound Sunset Highway and the ramp connecting Cornell Road/Bethany Boulevard to westbound Sunset Highway. These ramps will be closed at different times during the nighttime work for several hours at a time.
- ◆ Portable message signs will be placed on the highway and ramps to warn motorists of traffic impacts.
