Railroad work to impact U.S. 30 at Columbia City

Rail crossing project limits U.S. 30 to one lane with flaggers controlling both directions

A Portland & Western Railroad crossing replacement project in Columbia City will restrict U.S. 30 (Lower Columbia River Highway) to one lane with flaggers controlling both directions of traffic 24 hours a day. The lane closures will take place at Portland & Western's rail crossing, mile post 32.2, just west of Columbia City.

The work and lane restrictions are scheduled to begin at **7 a.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 9, and will end by 5 p.m. on Thursday, Oct. 11.** ODOT maintenance crews have built a temporary lane to the south side of U.S. 30 to handle both directions of traffic at the railroad crossing. Eastbound and westbound motorists on U.S. 30 will be alternately flagged through the temporary roadway. Motorists should expect delays.
