Weekend lane and ramp closures

Oregon Department of Transportation maintenance work and a utility project will close lanes and ramps on Portland metro area highways during the weekend as follows:

◆ **Guardrail repair on eastbound I-84 exit – Saturday, May 19, 5 a.m. to 7 a.m.**

An Oregon Department of Transportation maintenance crew will make repairs to damaged guardrail on the eastbound Interstate 84 off-ramp to 82nd Avenue on Saturday morning. The repairs will require the complete closure of the 82nd Avenue exit from eastbound I-84 during work hours. All lanes on I-84 will remain open during the work.

◆ **Columbia Slough Bridge work on I-5 – Sunday, May 20, 2 a.m. to 9 a.m.**

A contractor for ODOT will perform repairs to the Columbia Slough Bridge electrical navigation light system used by ships traveling on the waterway. The work will require the closure of the right lane on northbound Interstate 5 across the Columbia Slough Bridge, mile post 307.5, so crews can position a snooper crane on the bridge. Motorists will be able to use the Marine Drive on-ramp to northbound I-5 and the I-5 off-ramp to Jantzen Beach during the work.

◆ **Utility work on I-205 – Sunday, May 20, between 5:30 a.m. and 8 a.m.**

PGE will be using two rolling slowdowns of traffic on Interstate 205 just south of the Foster Road/Woodstock Boulevard interchange, mile post 17.41, to remove power lines that cross the freeway. The line removal is being done to accommodate TriMet's light-rail project. The rolling slowdowns will take place between 5:30 a.m. and 8 a.m. and may require up to 5-minute closures of traffic traveling on both directions of I-205. During the slowdowns, three ramps will be closed: Division Street and Powell Boulevard on-ramps to southbound I-205; and the Johnson Creek Boulevard on-ramp to northbound I-205.
