## **Southbound Fremont Bridge Opens on Time**

*Upper deck re-opened at 4:50 a.m. Monday*

Traffic started flowing over the upper deck of the Fremont Bridge at 4:50 a.m. Monday as contractors completed on schedule the first of three weekend closures for a deck reconstruction project.

The Interstate 405 closures are necessary to safely replace the epoxy asphalt concrete layer on a 2,159-foot section of the upper deck – the southbound lanes – at the crown of the bridge. The bridge's lower deck – the northbound lanes – will remain open during the upper deck work.

This was the first of three full weekend closures of southbound I-405 over the top deck of the Fremont. ODOT plans to close all southbound lanes again from 11 p.m. Friday to 5 a.m. Monday on the weekends of Aug. 5-8 and Aug. 19-22. The closure schedule is, of course, subject to change depending on weather and other factors.
