## **Highway enhancement project in Estacada**

***Motorists can expect minimal delays throughout the first phase of the project***

Oregon Department of Transportation contractor Eagle Elsner Inc. of Tigard is ready to begin work on the first phase of a preservation and beautification project on Oregon Highway 224 in downtown Estacada. Phase one of the project will include installing raised, planted medians; reconfiguring existing highway shoulders to include a standard-width bike lane and landscape strips with trees and plants; installing new street lights; and installing new ADA-standard sidewalks.

Daytime work is scheduled to begin the week of September 1 during the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Drivers can expect moving lane closures with flaggers controlling traffic. However, ODOT anticipates minimal traffic impacts as the shoulders are wide enough to allow traffic to move in each direction.

Phase one of the project is expected to be completed by January 2010. Phase two of the project, which will involve paving and striping from Eagle Creek to Estacada, is scheduled to begin in June 2010 and is estimated to be completed by September 2010.
