### **PILE DRIVING WORK CLOSES DAIRY CREEK BRIDGE**

An Oregon Department of Transportation bridge crew will close a portion of Highway 47 north of Banks next week. **Highway 47 will be closed between U.S. 26 (Sunset Highway) and Cedar Canyon/Banks Road.** The highway closure dates and times are as follows:

- Tuesday, Sept. 5 from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Wednesday, Sept. 6 from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. (if necessary)

The highway closure will allow workers to complete driving bridge pilings for the new bridge over the west fork of Dairy Creek.

During the highway closure hours, motorists will use U.S. 26 and Sellers Road as the detour route. Access for local residents will be maintained at all times.

In summer 2007, this same portion of Highway 47 will be closed 24 hours a day for up to three weeks so crews can remove the existing bridge and install the new bridge. The exact date for the bridge replacement work has not been determined. Notification will be sent out once a date is selected.
