Watch for roadside work next week on Oregon 551, I-5 at Canby-Hubbard exit 228

A geotech team will be drilling next week next to two Interstate 5 bridges over Oregon 551, the Wilsonville-Hubbard Highway, just south of I-5 Canby-Hubbard Exit 282, to gather information needed to replace the bridges in 2007.

All work will happen between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., off the highway shoulders. No traffic lanes will be closed. Drivers should watch for work zone signs, traffic cones and drilling equipment along the roadside.

Crews will drill five holes according to the following schedule:

Monday: Drilling off the right shoulder of southbound Oregon 551, the Wilsonville-Hubbard Highway, east of I-5.

Tuesday: Drilling off the left shoulder of southbound Oregon 551, the Wilsonville-Hubbard Highway, east of I-5.

Wednesday: Drilling off the right shoulder of southbound Oregon 551, the Wilsonville-Hubbard Highway, west of I-5.

Thursday: Drilling off the shoulder of the SB Miley Road (Charbonneau) on-ramp at I-5 exit 282.

Friday: Drilling in the median of I-5, north of the Oregon 551, Wilsonville-Hubbard Highway, bridges.

Wednesday, July 5: If necessary, the drillers will return to finish holes No. 3 and No. 4.
