### I-5 viaduct project lane closures near Terwilliger

*Overnight double lane closures tonight; weekend right lane closures continue*

**Starting at 10 p.m. tonight, Jan. 12, and ending at 5 a.m. Thursday, Jan. 13,** crews working to replace the Interstate 5 viaduct at Iowa Street will close the two right lanes of I-5 southbound throughout the project area, just north of the Terwilliger curves. The left lane will remain open. Crews will close the first right lane at 8 p.m.

During the closure, the contractor will unload additional equipment and move drilling equipment.

#### **Weekend right lane closure on I-5 south**

Work continues this weekend to demolish the existing retaining wall along I-5 southbound requiring an around-the-clock right lane closure.

**The southbound lane closure starts at 8 p.m. Friday, Jan. 14, and ends at 5:30 a.m. Monday, Jan. 17.**

The two left lanes of I-5 will remain open in both directions, but motorists should expect congestion on I-5 throughout the weekend.

During the weekend, the contractor will continue wall removal work during daytime hours. The wall debris will be removed during nighttime work hours.

The contractor will perform another around-the-clock right lane closure on I-5 southbound the weekend of Friday, Jan. 21 to Monday, Jan. 24.

This work is part of a \$32 million, three-year project to replace the viaduct, which was built in 1957.
