Nighttime ramp closures on I-5 in Portland

Paving will close on- and off-ramps Friday night; lanes on I-5 will not be impacted

A contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation will close several on- and off-ramps on Interstate 5 overnight from 9 p.m. Friday, April 30, to 9 a.m. Saturday, May 1.

This work will not impact travel lanes on I-5. Only one off-ramp will be closed at a time. The closures, which are required for a paving project, will take place as follows:

- **From 9 p.m. to 3 a.m., the contractor will close the I-5 southbound off-ramp to Alberta Street/Swan Island (exit 303).**

Motorists traveling to Alberta Street/Swan Island from I-5 southbound can take the Interstate 405 off-ramp to I-5 north to the Greely Avenue/Swan Island off-ramp (exit 302C).

- **From 10 p.m. to 9 a.m., the contractor will close the I-5 northbound off-ramp to U.S. 30 Bypass-Lombard Street East (exit 305A).** To prevent motorists from entering the work zone the contractor will close the Rosa Parks Way on-ramp to I-5 northbound.

Motorists traveling to U.S. Bypass-Lombard Street East from I-5 northbound can take the Columbia Boulevard off-ramp (exit 306A), east to Oregon Highway 99E (Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., south to U.S. 30 Bypass-N.E. Lombard Street.

This work is weather dependent and will be rescheduled if necessary.
