Lane and ramp closures on I-5 in Portland

Maintenance work will impact motorists during nighttime hours May 15-17

Crews from the Oregon Department of Transportation will perform various maintenance activities on **Interstate 5** beginning tonight and continuing through the weekend (May 15-17).

The work will take place as follows:

- **From 10 p.m., Friday, May 15, to 6 a.m., Saturday, May 16, ODOT crews will close the left lane on I-5 in both directions at Brier Place (mile post 297.5).** The closure is required to allow crews to perform repairs on the center barrier. The right and center lanes will remain open during the work.
- **From 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. on the nights of both Friday, May 15, and Saturday, May 16, ODOT crews will close all lanes on I-5 south between the Fremont Bridge/I-405 split and the Broadway on-ramp.** (The Broadway on-ramp to I-5 south will remain open during the work). The closure will allow crews to perform bridge joint maintenance and paving operations in the center lane of I-5. Motorists traveling on I-5 southbound will be detoured to I-405 southbound back to I-5. **This work will also require closing the Greeley Street on-ramp to I-5 southbound to prevent motorists from entering the work area.**

Please be aware of crews and equipment on the roadway during the closures.
