

## **Traffic Advisory**

### **SATURDAY LANE CLOSURES ON I-5**

ODOT maintenance crews will close the center and right lanes of southbound Interstate 5 tomorrow, Saturday, Sept. 17, between the Carman Drive and Nyberg Road interchanges for pavement repairs. Both lanes will close at 4 a.m. The center lane will reopen by 9 a.m. and the right lane will reopen by 11 a.m. During the work hours, the Carman Drive and Lower Boones Ferry Road on-ramps to southbound I-5 will be closed. Motorists bound for I-5 south will take I-5 north to the Kruse Way off-ramp, cross over the freeway and take the on-ramp to southbound I-5. As an alternate route, drivers can also take southbound Boones Ferry Road to Nyberg Road to I-5 south. Detour signs will be in place on I-5 to assist motorists. The Carman Drive, Lower Boones Ferry Road and Nyberg Road off-ramps from southbound I-5 will remain open at all times.

**Motorists are asked to use caution while driving through the construction zone and to expect delays.** If possible, drivers should consider taking I-205 as an alternate route. This work will not impact northbound I-5 traffic.
