Weekend I-5 North Double-Lane Closures

Shift to northbound I-5 Iowa viaduct detour happens overnight Friday and Saturday

Two lanes on Interstate 5 northbound will close overnight Friday, Aug. 5, and Saturday, Aug. 6, as traffic narrows to one lane in the Iowa Street Viaduct Project south of downtown Portland. The lane closures will take place each night from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. the next morning.

Motorists should expect congestion and delays. Use an alternate route if possible.

The lane closures are necessary to allow the contractor to move northbound traffic onto a detour alignment. This traffic alignment for northbound I-5 traffic will remain in place until the permanent I-5 viaduct is constructed.

After the northbound traffic shift, the contractor will demolish the existing northbound bridge over Iowa Street and begin constructing the new bridge and retaining walls along I-5 northbound.
