OVERNIGHT NORTHBOUND INTERSTATE BRIDGE CLOSURE PLANNED FOR JUNE 18

A full closure of the northbound span of the Interstate Bridge is planned for Saturday night June 18. All lanes of northbound Interstate 5 will be closed at the Interstate Bridge between 11 p.m. Saturday, June 18 and 7 a.m. Sunday, June 19. During the overnight closure period, a variety of maintenance crews from both the Oregon and Washington Departments of Transportation (ODOT and WSDOT) will perform work on or adjacent to the bridge. **The Delta Park, Denver Avenue and Jantzen Beach on-ramps to I-5 north will be closed during the overnight work hours; all other I-5 northbound on- and off-ramps will remain open throughout the night.** All southbound lanes of I-5 will remain open at all times.

Many tasks to complete

Activities scheduled to occur during the overnight closure include:

- Bridge counter-weight adjustments and test lifts
- Bridge deck inspections
- Lane striping
- Pavement and bridge joint inspections
- New sign installation

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Alternate Routes

Motorists traveling on I-5 north who are bound for Washington State can take I-84 east to I-205 north and cross into Washington via the Glenn Jackson Bridge. Drivers north of the I-84 interchange can also take Lombard Street east to I-205 north. Detour signs will be in place along Lombard Street.

Southbound Interstate Bridge Work

An overnight full closure of the southbound span of the Interstate Bridge will occur sometime in July. Notification will be sent out once a date is selected.
