Ross Island Bridge ramp to OR99E closed today

Bridge joint work closes the ramp from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Today from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Oregon Department of Transportation crews will close the eastbound **Ross Island Bridge (U.S. 26 Mt. Hood Highway) off-ramp to southbound Oregon Highway 99E (McLoughlin Boulevard).**

Crews are working to seal bridge joints on McLoughlin Boulevard between the Ross Island Bridge and SE Holgate. **The bridge joint work requires closing the right and center lane of McLoughlin Boulevard.** The Ross Island Bridge ramp closure will keep traffic out the work zone.

Detour:

Motorists traveling east on the Ross Island Bridge to Highway 99E will continue across the Ross Island Bridge, which becomes Powell Boulevard, then take the connecting ramp to S.E. 17th Avenue and continue south on S.E. 17th Ave. to Highway 99E.
