### **Ross Island Bridge ramp to OR99E closed today**

*Bridge joint work will close the ramp from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.*

**Today from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.** Oregon Department of Transportation crews will close the eastbound **Ross Island Bridge (U.S. 26 Mt. Hood Highway) off-ramp to southbound Oregon Highway 99E (Pacific Highway East)**. The closure will allow crews to bridge joint work on the ramp and on Highway 99E southbound.

**Detour:**

Motorists traveling east on the Ross Island Bridge to Highway 99E will continue across the Ross Island Bridge, which becomes Powell Boulevard, then take the connecting ramp to S.E. 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue and continue south on S.E. 17<sup>th</sup> Ave. to Highway 99E.
